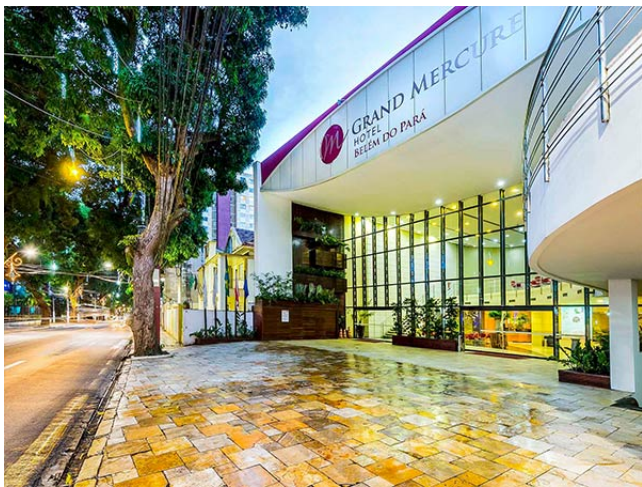

In the Pelourinho district (the Old Town), walk along charming cobbled lanes from the Municipal Square to Terreiro de Jesus square and view the splendid baroque cathedral, once the home of the largest Jesuit seminary outside Rome. Gaze upon its ornate interior, then visit Largo do Pelourinho Square and the San Francisco Church.

Your ship will anchor offshore here, and you'll be transported inland with either the use of tenders or zodiac crafts. French actress Brigitte Bardot made Búzios famous when she visited in 1964 and

transformed the little fishing village into the St. Tropez of South America. Ever since, it is the place for members of high society to be seen. More than 23 beaches grace this peninsular region. On an included tour by open-air trolley, you'll see many of them, including the wild and scenic Brava Beach, the pink sands of Forno Beach, and the unique rock formations of Point Lagoinha — known as the Brazilian Himalayas. There'll be time to linger and to swim if you wish, after which you may browse the posh shops downtown.

Your active walking tour will take place along narrow cobbled lanes that lead you into its heart. Admire original 18th-century architectural gems, including the 1722 Santa Rita de Cássia Church and the colonial mansion that hosts the House of Culture, which provides a fascinating chronicle of the town's role in Brazil's past. Pause to peruse charming boutiques and art galleries as you

explore, perhaps meeting some artists in residence.

DAY 23: Uncover the international spirit of Montevideo

Today you'll arrive in vibrant and sophisticated Montevideo, Uruguay, where you will get acquainted with this cultural capital on a city tour that takes in major monuments and highlights.

Plaza Independencia is the most important square in the city, located between the Ciudad Vieja (Old City) and the modern downtown area. This is where you'll find many of Montevideo's notable landmarks, including the Palacio Salvo and Teatro Solís. The Artigas Mausoleum, which houses the remains of political leader and Uruguayan national hero, José Gervasio Artigas, is also found here.

The Legislative Palace of Uruguay is another of the city's spectacular monument. Constructed in the early 20th century, this structure was built with 52 types of local marble and 12 distinct kinds of wood. You may also visit El Prado, an elegant neighborhood of sprawling botanical gardens and colonial mansions.
